



LEADERSHIP OVERLAND PARK SCHOLARSHIP



The **Leadership Overland Park (LOP) Scholarship** award is an educational fund that is designed to help in-need residents of Johnson County gain a professional or technical career. One in seven of Johnson County's population has an income below 200% of the federal poverty level and is considered low income. That was about 75,000 people in 2008. One half of Johnson County's poor are under age 25.

YOUR donation will make a collective impact on someone's life and help support their path out of poverty, improve adult literacy, and create a consistent source of funding to help less fortunate residents of Johnson County achieve successful careers. In addition, in recognition of the devastating economic consequences of the COVID-19 pandemic, in the first year of the scholarship preference will be given to an individual who can demonstrate that their financial well-being was adversely impacted by this pandemic.
